

## **Formal Foundations – Course Diary Guidelines**

Students are expected to keep a “Course Diary”, which contains all the work and experiments that are undertaken during the course, as well as their observations and reflections on their own learning process.

### **Unsatisfactory course diary**

Patchy account of solutions to the problems, mostly copied from Shaum.  
Some other materials, such as class tests.

### **Satisfactory course diary**

Good account of solutions to problems, with some evidence of student’s thought processes.  
Other material included, such as tests and class notes.  
Diagrams.  
Some evidence of independent study, such as material from web search.

### **Excellent course diary**

Very complete account of solutions to problems, with evidence of student’s thought processes and evaluations of strengths and weaknesses..  
Other material included, such as tests and class notes.  
Plenty of diagrams, and other material.  
Evidence of independent study, such as material from web search, following directions of interest.
